

# READ THE LANGUAGE OF PROPOSAL 3 FOR YOURSELF.

## PROPOSAL 3

**A PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO ESTABLISH NEW INDIVIDUAL RIGHT TO REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM, INCLUDING RIGHT TO MAKE ALL DECISIONS ABOUT PREGNANCY AND ABORTION; ALLOW STATE TO REGULATE ABORTION IN SOME CASES; AND FORBID PROSECUTION OF INDIVIDUALS EXERCISING ESTABLISHED RIGHT**

This proposed constitutional amendment would:

- Establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make and carry out all decisions about pregnancy, such as prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, contraception, sterilization, abortion, miscarriage management, and infertility;
- Allow state to regulate abortion after fetal viability, but not prohibit if medically needed to protect a patient's life or physical or mental health;
- Forbid state discrimination in enforcement of this right; prohibit prosecution of an individual, or a person helping a pregnant individual, for exercising rights established by this amendment;
- Invalidate state laws conflicting with this amendment.

- The word "individual" is the tip-off: If these new rights were only for adults, they would have said "adults." So be clear: all these new rights are for kids too.
- "Some cases" is a loophole. The state can "regulate" if it doesn't "infringe on that individual's autonomous decision-making." ANY regulation would infringe on *that*, so no regulating abortion at all.
- This isn't just about abortion. It includes sterilization, opening the door to kids choosing gender-change therapies or puberty-blocking drugs without their parent's consent.
- HUGE loophole here! It's not just doctors determining what's medically necessary. A long list of "health care professionals," including social workers, chiropractors, and even massage therapists, could authorize late-term abortions.
- This one is a shocker. This prohibits any accountability for an abortion clinic if they injure — or even kill — a woman, even in cases of gross negligence.
- This should make you mad! It "invalidates all state laws," but doesn't tell you which laws! We will; the laws requiring parental consent, banning taxpayer-paid abortions, late-term and partial-birth abortions, requiring only doctors to perform abortions, and even safety inspections for abortion clinics: ALL INVALIDATED! No wonder they didn't tell you!
